Not just a place to store your vintage and exotic autos, the **Bridgehampton Motoring Club** is also the ultimate hangout for enthusiasts.

IN THE HAMPTONS, all car owners face the same set of problems. The high humidity accelerates the rust process; sand particles in the air damage paint finish; and the sun—a beachgoers' best friend—is your car interior's worst enemy. The typical solution is to merely place a car in the garage, but if a house in the Hamptons even has a garage, it's likely filled with bikes, boogie boards and children's toys. Built out of necessity and love by two major car enthusiasts, the BMC was established in 2001 as a home for those cars that require the special care that only a warehouse storage facility can provide. The hardtop building, which utilizes constant temperature and humidity control, provides 24-hour, year-round security for your vehicle. All car batteries are kept on a trickle charge, which is especially important during the winter months if you don't plan on driving for an extended period of time. An entire menu of mechanical, detailing and maintenance services are offered, as well as pickup and drop-off anywhere in the Hamptons via a flatbed truck.
